As a school we pride ourselves on the way that our children are respectful, courteous and kind to all members of our community—we focus on this lots as an inclusive school and talk to the children about accepting and celebrating difference: be it hair/eye/skin colour, boy/girl, religion, ability or Special Needs.

If we can also ask for your support in this, as children (especially those in the younger age groups) take their lead from what they see and hear at home.

Experience has taught us that including and supporting children (and their parents) has a quicker, longer lasting impact than excluding and ostracising them: Putting ourselves in the shoes of the struggling child/parent and thinking “how would I feel if this was my child” can help us consider how we are reacting or speaking to/about others children. Thank you for supporting us with this.

You said—we did

For some time we have been working with other agencies to develop a school **Healthy Eating Policy**. This is quite complex as it not only involves snacks and lunchtime but also what we teach the children in terms of food, nutrition and cooking plus what we provide as snacks/tuck at fundraising and PTA events.

Caring Cooks have agreed to work with us to help us develop this further and begin working towards being a “Sugar Free School”. More information about this will be coming home soon.
