Next Week in Year 2

Maths:

Next week we will be moving onto division. Looking at grouping, sharing and dividing by 2, 5 and 10.

English:

Next week we will be looking at the story of Jutland Jack. We will be looking at his life and how it compares to our lives now. We will be discovering about how the events of WW1 impacted on his life.

Home Learning Activities:

Homework is set on a Tuesday due in the Monday of the following week. This week's tasks are:

- Spellings - please can the children have a go at putting their spellings into sentences, this is to show that they understand what the word means. Spellings will be tested on Mondays.
- Reading: The children will be taking new reading books home once a week, please make sure they have their books in their bags every day. Please read with your child for 15 minutes each night. There are home reader books available for you to borrow from just inside the classroom, please help yourself and let me know if you have taken one.

Children's books cannot be changed if they do not bring their old book and reading diary in with them. This is to ensure that we keep full sets of books together at school.
