This term we are hoping to be joining other schools in the pilot "school review" programme that is being currently being trialled across Jersey. This involves visitors coming to St Luke's and giving us valuable feedback as to how the school operates, what is working well and what our next steps towards being even better. Once we have more information we will share with you what the outcomes, celebrations and recommendations are after the review.

You said we did

It was brought to our attention that the number of bikes and scooters was causing difficulty for parents coming in with pushchairs. As such we have moved the school bins to another location which opens up the entrance space.

Jersey Premium is a targeted funding programme for schools which has been introduced to help all children get the very best from their education. There are three eligibility criteria:

1. All pupils who are 'Looked After Children';
2. Children from households which have claimed Income Support for a total of 12 months or more within the last five years;
3. Children from households with 'Registered' status that would qualify to claim Income Support if they had lived in Jersey for five years.

If you think your family would qualify for Income Support if you had lived in the Island for five years, you can find out if your child is eligible for Jersey Premium by completing a short questionnaire. This is available from school and the Education Department.
