Maths:

We are learning about : Length and Height

- To be able to compare height and length using key terminology.
- To be able to measure objects using other items as non-standard units of measure, such as pencils or paper clips.
- To be able to measure the height and length of items using parts of the body.
- To be able to understand the concept of using rulers for measuring height and length.
- To be able to apply knowledge of length and height to solve problems.

English:

Reading

This week we will be reading a range of recipes to become familiar with the layout and what should be included i.e. equipment list. We will also be looking at the skill of self-correction, when our reading doesn't make sense.

Writing

This week in writing we will be looking at instructional texts i.e. recipes and learning the following writing skills:

- Putting instructions in the correct order and numbering them.
- Writing simple instructional sentences starting with a bossy verb.
- Using a time connective i.e. first, next, after that.

We will be writing our own instructions after baking some gingerbread people. (Please let me know of any allergies)

Home Learning Activities:

Daily Reading – Please remember to read every night with your child – also sharing a bed time story with your child where they read one page and then you read the other is a good way to encourage enjoyment of reading.

Spelling: This week we have looked at the sound 'ea'. If you have time please have ago at writing a sentence with your child which includes a word from their spelling list.

-Thinking ahead to our Christmas decorations – we are creating Christmas Stars with the children out of small twigs. We are therefore looking for twig donations –if you are walking in any woods or parks or have a garden with fallen braches please collect small twigs and bring into school – this would be much appreciated.
