Next week in Year 2

Maths:

Next week we will be moving onto mass. We will be measuring in kilograms and grams and comparing masses.

English:

We will be using our literacy time to practice and prepare for our class assembly.

Home Learning Activities:

Homework is set on a Tuesday due in the Monday of the following week. This week's tasks are:

- Spellings - please can the children have a go at putting their spellings into sentences, this is to show that they understand what the word means. Spellings will be tested on Mondays.
- The children have science based homework this week. They need to draw or stick a photo of themselves at each age a write a bit underneath about what they were like at that age. What could they do/ not do? How had they changed?
- Reading: The children will be taking new reading books home once a week, please make sure they have their books in their bags every day. Please read with your child for 15 minutes each night. There are home reader books available for you to borrow from just inside the classroom, please help yourself and let me know if you have taken one.

Children's books cannot be changed if they do not bring their old book and reading diary in with them. This is to ensure that we keep full sets of books together at school.

Dates for the diary:

P.E days will be on **Mondays** and **Fridays**. Please can children come to school wearing their P.E kit on these days.

Tuesday 27th November

We are very lucky to have been invited to the Georgian Town House to experience 'A Traditional Christmas'. We will be returning to school after our lunch time and so will be having a later lunch. Please could the children have an additional snack that they can have before we leave along with their usual snack.

Christmas Fayre : Friday 30th November

In the run up to the Christmas Fayre there will be an interclass bottle stall competition. The class that collects the most points will win a movie and popcorn afternoon!

The competition will be judged the evening before the fayre.

Other news...

- Change of P.E day. This half term we will have cricket coaches with us on Fridays, therefore, P.E will no longer be on Thursdays.
- Shoe laces - if you are sending your child into school wearing lace up shoes please can they be taught how to tie their shoe laces. I have set the children the challenge of learning how to do this before they come back to school after Christmas.
- Snack will be kept in a tray in the classroom from now on; this is so the children don't have to spend time getting it out their bags during the day. Please can we ask that the snack if put in a named container or bag.
- Year 2 will be joining Reception and Year 1 for their nativity. We will be singing along with them as well as performing our own song. You are more than welcome to join us for this at 2pm of Friday 7th December at St. Luke's Church.
