Next Week in Year 6...

Maths

We are continuing our work on 'Operations'.

We will be focusing on multiplying 2, 3 and 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers.

Please ensure your child is confident in their timetable knowledge as this will greatly help them.

Writing/History

We are starting our World War 1 topic for the next 3 weeks. We will be learning:

- That it is 100 years since the outbreak of 'The Great War' which we now know as WW1.
- Know how and when the war started/ended.
- Understand something of a soldier's life on the front line & in trenches.

(<https://spellingframe.co.uk/>) is also a great online place to practise spellings from Y3-Y6).

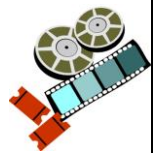
Writing: Activity on relative clauses which children have been looking at in class.
