Next week in Reception

Maths:

Space Shape and Measure: We will continue to look at 3D shapes, naming them and beginning to describe them. The children will be using mathematical language such as 'faces' to describe the shapes.

Literacy:

Reading: We are focusing on our blending skills (when we put sounds together to say the word) e.g. c-a-t, m-a-t and then saying the word 'mat'. Children need to point to each sound as they see and it and say it and then run their finger under the word.

Home Learning Activities:

Ongoing homework tasks:

- Daily Phonics
- Ordering Numbers to 20
- Reading Books (if your child is taking home a book. Please share a story book with your child or a book from our lending library if they are currently not on the school reading scheme.
