Next Week in Year 1

Maths:

We are learning about : Solving Word Problems

- To be able to decide whether addition or subtraction is the most appropriate operation.
- To be able to use and apply number bonds and visual representations to solve word problems.
- To be able to use and apply concepts of how many more and how many fewer/less.
- To be able to apply number bonds and the guess-and-check method to solve word problems.
- To be able to develop number sentences based on word problems.
- To be able to use pictorial representations to help solve word problems.

English:

Reading and Writing

- This week the children will be focusing on plant growth.
- We will be recalling the way that Jack's 'magic' beans grew and make magic beans of our own using shiny collage materials and bean seeds, and invent magic bean stories.
- This will be followed by planting fast-growing seeds and predicting what will happen, writing labels and focusing on use of capital letters as the children learn to fill in a growth charts for their seedlings.
- The children will demonstrate their understanding of the parts of a plant by creating zigzag books about them.
- There will be a focus on using the correct word endings and sentence grammar.
- Finally, the children will help Jack to plant and look after his seeds correctly by writing instruction sheets for him.

Home Learning Activities:

Daily Reading – This week with reading, to link with the children's learning in school, can you ask them to remember key information from the text. For example Who did that in the story? Where did they come from? Where was the story set? Why did they go there?

Homework: The homework set this week is a reading activity for the children to complete. Please encourage and support your child to read the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. Afterwards they need to answer the questions on the back of the sheet using FULL SENTENCES and reminding them to start with a capital letter and end with a full stop.

The children will be travelling to and from the zoo on a church. Please ensure your child has a coat, hat and gloves on the day as there will be time to see a few of the animals after our lesson.

Please can I remind parents that children should be bringing in their book bags everyday so that we can put notices/ homework/ children's work in it to go home.

Other News:

- Our new Science topic is all about – Materials and their properties. The children will be investigating what materials different objects are made from and considering their properties and how they are suited for each object.
