Castle	Large building, build to protect people from attack.

National Curriculum

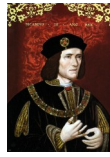

Queen Elizabeth was the first female to rule England.

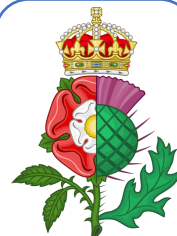
She was a brave Tudor queen who defeated the Spanish Armada.
