

## JERSEY PREMIUM

### If you arrived in Jersey within the last five years, your child could qualify for Jersey Premium Funding.

Jersey Premium helps children to get the best from their education.

Your child’s school could receive extra funding through Jersey Premium to boost their learning. Schools choose to use Jersey Premium Funding in different ways, depending on what would help children most. For example, they might get extra help with English and Mathematics, support for reading, extra equipment or the use of clubs before or after school.

#### Who is eligible?

- Children who live in a household receiving Income Support
- **Children who live in a ‘Registered’ household that *could* receive Income Support (i.e. it meets the requirements of the Social Security Department) but have not yet lived in Jersey for five years or more**
- Looked After Children (i.e. who are under the care of Social Services)

#### What you need to do

If you have not yet lived in Jersey for five years or more **AND** believe you could receive Income Support, please answer the questions below and return the form to your child’s school. Your answers will help us to establish whether your child is eligible for Jersey Premium funding. Please complete one form for your whole family.

**HOUSEHOLD**

A **household** is defined as follows:

- a single parent or couple (married, unmarried or civil partners) living together at the same address with children under school leaving age

A young adult, up to the age of 25, who is a jobseeker or in full time education should be included in the family household.

Any other family members should not be included in the Household, even if they share a property with you i.e. please do not include elderly relatives that may live with you.
