it as you can. I will also be taking parts from it to put on Seesaw to see children's understanding and learning so please check there first before printing anything out.

- **Spellings:** I have assigned this week's spellings to the Year 2 section of the website; please find your child's group on the document- Group 1, Group 2 or Group 3. I have now set up an area on Seesaw to submit spelling tests to show me how your child has done, I am also in the process of trying to find some spelling games that I can link into Seesaw, keep a look out for them!
- **Learning Project:** This week the theme for the learning project is about Food. If your child does any work related to this project I have made a learning tab for it on Seesaw, please feel free to attach any work related to the project on there.
- **PSHE:** The Right that children will learn next week is Article 14 - Freedom of thought, belief and religion. Please go through the PowerPoint with your child and complete some of the activities- thank you.
