St Luke's Day

Monday 18th October is St Luke's Day where we learn about who St Luke was but also a little about the history of our school.

There are records of St Luke's School being established around the 1880's making us almost 140 (ish) years old. St Luke's became a States school in 1913.

We are hoping to celebrate with a street party/event next summer/ early Autumn).

Jersey Premium is a targeted funding programme for schools which has been introduced to help all children get the very best from their education. There are three eligibility criteria:

1. All pupils who are 'Looked After Children';
2. Children from households which have claimed Income Support for a total of 12 months or more within the last five years;
3. Children from households with 'Registered' status that would qualify to claim Income Support if they had lived in Jersey for five years.

If you think your family would qualify for Income Support if you had lived in the Island for five years, you can find out if your child is eligible for Jersey Premium by completing a short questionnaire. This is available from school and the Education Department.
