Activity: Online program to encourage and develop fluency with times tables.	
Cost: £72.00	
Project and Rationale No More Marking	
Aim: To use comparative judgement to provide a quicker, more reliable method of assessment to enable teachers to accurately assess and plan for children's next step.	
Activity: Children to take part in No More Marking task. Teacher to upload and national comparisons made.

Project and Rationale: Third Space Learning	Impact
Aim: Attainment in Maths to increase with the aim to be at least in line with Jersey averages.	
Activity: 1-1 online Maths tutor to provide bespoke sessions focusing on gaps in learning and extension.

Project and Rationale: Reading Recovery	Impact
Aim: Children make greater progress in Reading and close the gap between them and their peers.	
Activity: Supply Teacher to provide 1-1 reading recovery program.	
Cost: £34,500	
Project and Rationale Nessy	Impact
Aim: To accelerate progress in children's reading fluency in reading and comprehension.	
Activity: Online program to encourage and develop fluence with reading and comprehension.	
Cost: £1022.50

Activity: All senior leaders to get a day out of class to enable them to develop the leadership areas they are responsible for.	
Cost: £18,400	
Project and Rationale	Impact
JPP Class Teacher Release Time	
Aim: To ensure that teachers get dedicated time each week to work in small groups with children in receipt of JPP to work on already identified targets/areas for development (these will be different in all classes ranging from Nursery- Year Six)	
Activity: Teacher to cover classes to enable class teachers to run booster group sessions with small groups of children.	
Cost: £22,080
