This intervention had good impact last year when run in school full time.
Project and Rationale: Reading Recovery	Impact
Aim: Children make greater progress in Reading and close the gap between them and their peers.  Activity: Supply Teacher to provide 1-1 reading recovery program.  Cost: £9,660	<ul> <li>Due to COVID this was unable to take place as a full programme.</li> <li>Most recent weekly summaries from Reading Recovery Teacher find that children taking part have increased from a minimum of 1 reading level to a maximum of 15 reading levels so far.</li> <li>This intervention will run again 2020/2021 and impact will be closely monitored.</li> </ul>
