It probably won't surprise you to know, that we have been very impressed by the high quality learning going on everywhere. Mr Willis especially enjoyed walking through school, spending time talking with the children who he said were highly enthusiastic and engaged with everything they were learning. A special shout out to all our amazing staff who are daily going above and beyond looking for imaginative ways to inspire the children and achieve accelerated progress.

Parent Survey results

The results from our latest parent Survey have been published on our school website. Thank you to everyone for your feedback. We were really pleased to see positive feedback being higher than previous years, in many areas. Areas that have seen an increase in positive responses are:

- + 97% Families who feel any concerns they raise are dealt with properly.
- + 98% Families who feel their child does well at St Luke's.
- + 96% Families who feel St Luke's has high expectations for their children.
- + We are really pleased to see the number of families who have said their child has experienced bullying has reduced (now down to only 5.6%). Sadly 2 responses to this question said that it hadn't been dealt with in a way they had wanted. As they didn't provide their names we are unable to contact them to offer support directly. Please do get in contact with us if this was you and you feel we can support you with this moving forwards.

We will now spend time going through your responses and looking at the areas that you feel we need to further develop. In our next Newsletter we will add a "You Said, We did" section that will enable us to give you more information and let you know what we will be putting in place. Our aspiration being that we reach 100% for positive responses in our next survey.
