On Friday 22nd November we will be having an Entertainer/Disco after school —ticket information to follow soon

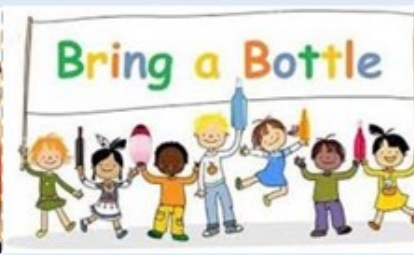
No nuts, please!
