97% responded that they felt safe in school.



100% said they learnt about their rights at school.



97% said they were encouraged to look after their physical health.



92% said if they felt unsafe they could tell an adult in school.

61% had spoken to their parents about children's rights.

23% had spoken to their wider family, 23% had spoken to other adults outside of the school,

And 35% had spoken to other children outside of the school.

97% said that children in their class were kind and helpful.

69% responded that they felt bullying was something school needs to keep as a high priority.

97% said that school encouraged them to treat everyone with respect.



97% said they could do things to help others in our local community.

Achieve



98% said that adults dealt with poor behaviour in the classroom, while 91% said that adults dealt with poor behaviour on the playground.

Care



95% said school helped them understand what they need to do to improve.

95% said they could do things to help others around the world.

100% answered that they used the internet at home

71% said they use the internet in their bedroom.
60% said they use the internet in a room with their family.
40% said they use the internet somewhere else.

100% said they accessed the internet on a gaming device (Xbox, PlayStation, Switch, etc).

48% said they accessed the internet on a PC or laptop.

58% said they accessed the internet on their phone.

80% said they accessed the internet on their tablet.

27% said they accessed the internet on something else (e.g. smart TV).

43% said they spoke to their parents about what they were doing on the internet

57% said their parents had rules for using the internet.

97% said they watch videos online.

48% said their parents monitored what they were watching online.

61% said they knew how to use the privacy and security settings on their devices.

41% said they had limits on their screen time on weekdays and 33% had limits at weekends.

97% said that they had learnt about online safety at school.

Have you ever...
63% have posted photos of themselves.
37% have posted videos of themselves.
5% have taken part in a live broadcast.

32% of children reported that they **don't** always feel safe online.

84% said they knew more about online safety than their Mum or Dad.

26% have commented on someone else's photos.
52% have commented on someone else's video.

50% of children reported to have seen something that upset them online.

80% of children knew what to do or who to talk to if someone said something hurtful to them or if something made them feel uncomfortable when online.
