Following recent events at a local secondary school, we want to reassure parents that St Luke's has a comprehensive lockdown policy, which is available to view on our website. All schools are required to hold annual lockdown drills to ensure the safety and preparedness of our children and staff. We will inform parents well in advance of when the drill will take place and explain what it will involve. To prevent any distress, all children will be fully briefed beforehand.
