<p>What job do I do?</p>	<p>Education Welfare Officer</p>
<p>Where do I work?</p>	<p>I am based at the Education Department but spend a lot of time in schools and homes with children and their families.</p>
<p>When might you work with me?</p>	<p>I support children when their school attendance or lateness is a concern and affecting their progress.</p>
<p>What does a typical day look like in my job?</p>	<p>A typical day for me would be talking with parents and children early in the morning and sometimes going to family homes to help children to get to school.</p> <p>I often go to schools for meetings with teachers and children to make sure that we are doing everything we can to support children in the best way possible.</p> <p>I work very closely with other agencies that support children to make sure that children's voices are heard and that we are all keeping them safe.</p> <p>I also deliver a positive parenting programme called 'Triple P' that give parents ideas to deal with the big and small problems of family life in order to raise happy, confident kids.</p>
<p>What do I like most about my job?</p>	<p>I really enjoy working directly with children and young people and making sure that their views are heard.
