## Next week in Year 2...

### Maths:

Next week we will be focusing on addition and subtraction, children will focus on adding two 2-digit numbers, with renaming of ones and subtracting ones from a 2-digit number without renaming.

### English:

**Literacy:** We are continuing using The Day The Crayons Quit to learn about letter writing. Children will learn to use coordinating conjunctions (or, and, but) to extend their sentences.

### Home Learning Activities:

Homework is set on a Wednesday and due in the Tuesday of the following week. This week's tasks are:

- **Spellings** - please can all children practise their spellings. These have been stuck into their orange homework books. Spellings will be tested on **Tuesday**.
- **Reading:** the children are encouraged to change their reading books from the home reader boxes in the classroom whenever they need to. They may need a gentle reminder on occasion and we will continue to do this each morning. These books are currently being re-levelled. Please continue read with your child for 15 minutes each night and record this in their reading diary. Thank you.

**Update:** From Friday next week all children will be taking home the levelled guided reading book they would have read in sessions over the week. This is to reinforce tricky words and to practise talking in more depth about the content of the book. These levelled books must be returned on a Monday and will be signed in and out. If they are not returned children will not be given a new book to take home.

Please remember that any concerns or questions that you may have about Home Learning can be written in the Home Learning diary if you aren't able to catch me at the start or end of the day. I am always happy to help!

- **Maths:** please can all children be practising their times tables on Times Table Rockstars as much as possible. We are focusing on the 2x table at school at the moment.
