## Next week in Year 2...

### Maths:

Next week we will be continuing with our focus on numbers to 100, looking at counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 forwards and backwards.

### English:

**Literacy:** We will continue looking at Fairy Tales by comparing two versions of Rapunzel and looking more in depth at the problems Rapunzel encountered during the story.

### Home Learning Activities:

Homework is set on a Wednesday and due in the Tuesday of the following week. This week's tasks are:
