Next week in Year 2...

Maths:

Next week we will be continuing with our focus on place value. Children will be learning about more than and less than signs.

English:

Handwriting: we will be practising the diagonal join such as 'ei'
Literacy: We will be reading various fairy tales to understand the structure and features of them.

Homework is set on a Wednesday and due in the Tuesday of the following week. This week's tasks are:

- **Spellings** - please can all children practise their spellings. These have been stuck into their new orange homework books. Spellings will be tested on **Tuesday**.
