

# Year 3 Weekly News

<p><b>Maths:</b> We will be finishing off our section on subtraction before we look at the various ways we can represent addition and subtraction.</p>	<p><b>English:</b> <b>Handwriting:</b> we will be continuing to look at joining 'ri', 'ru', 'rn' and 'rp'. These are joins from r with no ascender. <b>Writing:</b> We will be using the characters for 'The Plot on the Pyramid' to write character descriptions.</p>
<p><b>Home Learning Activities:</b> Homework is set on a Wednesday due in the Tuesday of the following week. This week's tasks are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Spellings</b> - please can the children have a go at putting their spellings into sentences, this is to show that they understand what the word means. Spellings will be tested on <b>Tuesday</b>.</li> <li><b>Reading:</b> The children will be taking new reading books home once a week; these will go home on Friday and must be returned on the Monday. The books that the children take home will be the book that they have looked at in our reading sessions during the week and so they will be familiar with the book. Please ensure that this book is returned each Monday - unfortunately any non returned book will result in us being unable to issue a new book the next week.</li> <li>Children are encouraged to use our Home Reader boxes to take and change their own reading books to read at home during the week.</li> <li>Please read with your child for 15 minutes each night and record this in their diaries. Thank you!</li> <li><b>Maths:</b> this homework is set weekly; this will always be linked to what we have been focusing on in maths lessons in class.</li> </ul> <p><b>Times Tables Rock Stars:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All children should be accessing this at home as part of their homework. Children should be aiming for 3-4 times a week for between 10-20 minutes at least. Please encourage children to access to increase their fluency, speed and confidence.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Dates for the diary:</b> P.E days will be on <b>Tuesdays</b> and <b>Fridays</b>. Please could children come to school wearing their P.E kit on these days? Thank you!</p> <p><b>Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November:</b> We will be having an Egyptian Day on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November. On this day the children can come to school dressed as anything Ancient Egyptian - pharaoh, archaeologist or mummy!</p> <p>We will be spending the day looking at all things Ancient Egypt, exploring famous pharaohs and traditions.</p>
