## Next week in Year 2...

### Maths:

Next week we will be learning about multiplication methods, focusing on the 2 and 5 times tables.

### English:

We will be continuing using the text 'The Wonder' by Faye Hanson to learn about how we infer from texts and also how and why we use exclamation marks.

### Home Learning Activities:

Homework is set on a Wednesday and due in the Tuesday of the following week. This week's tasks are:

- **Spellings** - please can all children practise their spellings. These have been stuck into their orange homework books. Spellings will be tested on **Tuesday**.
- **Maths**- children are to complete the function machines using their subtraction knowledge. Please do not spend hours on this, 30 minutes focused learning is fine. If the sheet is not finished do not worry!
- **Reading:**  
As the children are in Middle Phase (Year 2 and Year 3) the routine for taking home books has changed from the system which was followed in Early Phase (Reception and Year 1).  
Each week the children will be taking home :
  1. A guided levelled book that has been part of their reading sessions during the week.
  2. A library book
  3. At least one book from the home reader book boxes. The children will be reminded daily about this.

In addition to this, children who are reading below the expected level for their age will also be bringing home a book from their ECOF support session.
