Next week in Year 2...

Maths:

Next week Year 2 will be learning about families of multiplication and division facts such as $5 \times 2 = 10$, $2 \times 5 = 10$, $10 \div 5 = 2$ and $10 \div 2 = 5$. We will also recap odd and even numbers.

English:

Next week Year 2 will be putting their handwriting practise into action and writing out their character descriptions for display. We will also be briefly learning about Calligram poems.

Home Learning Activities:

Homework is set on a Wednesday and due in the Tuesday of the following week. This week's tasks are:

- **Spellings** - please can all children practise their spellings. These have been stuck into their orange homework books. Spellings will be tested on **Tuesday**.
- **Reading** - please continue to read with your child for 15 minutes each night and record this in their reading diary. Thank you.
