Next Week in Year 5...

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing on Multiplication and Division.


Consolidating 3-digit by 2-digit multiplication, then moving onto forms of division.

We are practising several methods. With children discussing ways in which each is efficient or inefficient.

English

Writing: Next week children will understand how tension can be built within short narratives. Making selections in vocabulary and punctuation to develop this.

Reading: Our reading sessions are still being rotated in groups from vocabulary, comprehension, grammar and group reading with an adult. Reading assessments results are available to children from Friday if they wish to know their scores.



Year 5 Home learning expectations:

Maths task:

This week children have a task that is aiming to consolidate their work on 4-digit by 1-digit multiplication.

Spellings:

Children completed their spelling test this week. Therefore, children will be tested on their next list (List 10) next Tuesday.

Reading: Please aim to read every night for 20 minutes and record it in your reading diary. These need to be given in alongside homework books please.
